Shanti Stupa – A dazzling white-domed stupa perched atop a hill, offering panoramic views of Leh and the surrounding mountains. Built to promote world peace, it glows beautifully at sunset and under moonlight. A spiritual haven with stunning photo ops – serenity meets skyline!

Shey Monastery – Once the summer capital of Ladakh's kings, Shey Monastery is home to a massive golden Buddha statue and ancient murals. Surrounded by barley fields and mountains, it's perfect for history buffs and peace seekers. A timeless gem echoing spiritual heritage and royal legacy.

Pangong Lake – A surreal, high-altitude lake that changes colors from blue to green to golden. Stretching into Tibet, it's a favorite for road trippers and filmmakers. Camp by the shores, gaze at the stars, and experience the raw, untouched magic of Ladakh. Simply otherworldly!

Diskit Monastery – The oldest and largest monastery in Nubra Valley, famous for its towering Maitreya Buddha statue overlooking the valley. A peaceful retreat with stunning mountain views and deep spiritual vibes. A must-visit for soulful moments and Insta-worthy landscapes!

Nubra Valley – A desert in the sky, where sand dunes meet snow-capped peaks. Ride double-humped Bactrian camels in Hunder, explore monasteries, and witness the confluence of cultures. With its dramatic terrain and serene vibes, Nubra is Ladakh's hidden treasure!

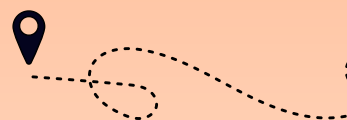
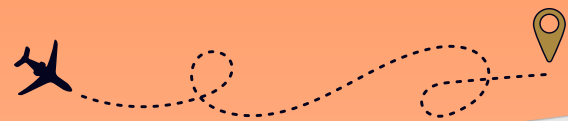


Leh Arrival



Day-1

- Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel

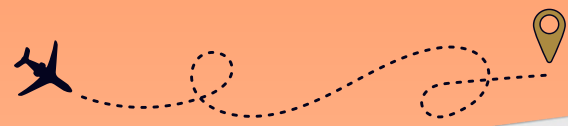


Leh Local Sightseeing

Day-3

- After breakfast, drive to Nubra Valley via Khardung-La - the world's highest motorable road at 5,359 meters
- Known as the Valley of Flowers, Nubra lies between the Karakoram and Ladakh ranges, offering surreal landscapes
- Upon arrival, check in to your hotel and unwind
- Later, head to the famous sand dunes - the cold desert of India - and enjoy an optional camel safari on double-humped Bactrian camels
- Visit diskit monastery , then return to the hotel for dinner and an overnight stay

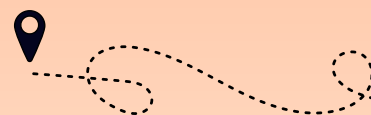


Nubra Valley- Pangong Tso-Shyok



Day-4

- After breakfast, check out and begin your journey to the stunning Pangong Tso via the scenic Agam and Shyok villages
- Pangong Tso is one of Asia's most mesmerizing lakes, known for changing its colors 4-5 times a day
- Also called the "Lake of the Great Hollow," it is Asia's largest saltwater lake with crystal-clear waters that glisten in varying shades of blue
- Surrounded by mountains painted in earthy tones, the lake offers a divine view – a truly surreal experience at 4,300 meters above sea level
- Upon arrival, check in to your lakeside campsite. Enjoy dinner and an overnight stay under the stars

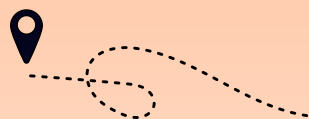


Pankong Tso- Chang la- Leh

- En route, drive through Chang-La – the world's second-highest motorable pass at 5,350 meters

- Return to the hotel for dinner and a comfortable overnight stay
